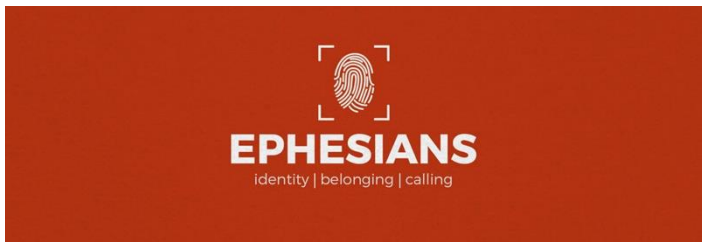


15 SUMMARY
